

DOMINOS

game instructions

GAME RULES

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: 2-4 (teams of 2 permitted)

- Place dominos face down, to shuffle on a flat surface. Each player draws one domino to decide who goes first (highest double or highest number wins).
- Players start with a hand of 7 dominoes.
- Remaining dominoes are left face down on the table in the draw-stack.
- If a player cannot play a domino from their own hand, they are to draw from the stack and forfeit the rest of their turn.

SCORING

- Score points by laying the dominos end to end, the touching ends must match.
- If the dots on the exposed ends total any multiple of five, the player is awarded that number of points.
- All sides of the first double may be used one piece to each side and later one to each end. All other doubles are played at right angles to the line and the total points on both ends are counted.
- Dominoing occurs when one player goes out by playing all of his dominoes. The sum of the spots of all opposing players is computed and added to the dominoing player's score.
- In partnership play, the spots of the partner of the one who "DOMINOED" are not counted.
